



### January Focus on Dental Health

Did you know that your cat can experience major health problems related to his or her teeth, including dental tartar, gingivitis, and infection; dental resorptive lesions; and stomatitis? These problems may increase the likelihood that your kitty suffers from pain due to dental disease, or develops systemic diseases that may affect the liver, kidney, or heart.

Your feline friend's teeth need to be regularly scaled and polished, just like yours. Home care, including tooth brushing, dental diets, and dental chews, can help preserve your kitty's teeth while promoting great overall health.

### It's Time to Schedule Your Kitty's Annual Exam

It's important that your fuzzy friend receives an annual wellness exam. An annual exam not only checks the current state of your kitty's health, it is also an important part of an ongoing preventative healthcare program that can detect potential medical issues before they become serious.

During an annual exam, your kitty's eyes, ears, nose, and mouth will be examined. The doctor will listen to the heart and lungs through a stethoscope, which can detect potential heart murmurs, arrhythmias, or abnormal heart rates, as well as bronchial or lung congestion. Your kitty's lymph nodes, musculoskeletal system, and skin and coat will also be checked; the doctor will feel the abdominal organs for possible abnormalities.

The veterinarians at the Sacramento Cat Hospital are here to help guide you and your kitty through his or her lifetime of care, from kittenhood to maturity and on through the senior years. Call 916-488-4161 now to schedule your appointment for your kitty's annual exam.



Many vaccines used at vaccine clinics are adjuvanted, which means they contain an additive to help the cat's body absorb the vaccine. Unfortunately, the adjuvanted vaccines have been shown to cause inflammation or even cancerous tumors at the injection site.
